- ❖ Program orientation is on Sunday January 10, 2010. Our mandatory (and fundatory) weekend retreat runs from Saturday, January 30th at 8am to Sunday, January 31st at 6pm (all meals provided).
- ❖ White Center meets on Tuesdays 6-8pm starting 1/12/10 and South End meets on Wednesdays from 6-8pm, starting 1/13/10.
- Sundays take you to the mountains (for snowboarding) or the streets (for volunteer service). On snowboarding days, plan on being up really early and being home around 6 pm (breakfast and lunch provided).
- ❖ The fee for *snowboarding* is only \$25 per trip. Scholarships are available, but remember that, for just \$25, we provide you with transportation, a lift ticket, Odwalla, equipment, instruction, lunch and **Sno**wboard **Con**nection gear.
- ❖ tSB class of 2010 officially ends in June 2010, but the opportunities keep going and going and going.
